Dick Jordan Timberline High School Boise	11th-12th grades AP Biology, Environmental Science, AP Environmental Science	Support for first annual "OUTrageous Race." Student teams will go through educational stations to learn about ecology and stewardship on their way to the finish line.
John Klapp Seltice Elementary School Post Falls	2nd grade Gifted Education	Support for a unit on reforestation after forest fires. Funds will purchase books and DVDs to enhance brochures and other resources.
Kerinsa Sanborn Spirit Lake Elementary School	2nd grade All subjects	Support for annual "Walk in the Woods" field day, including lunches for presenters and portable toilet rental.
Joseph Timchak & Carol Smith Taylorview Jr. High School Idaho Falls	9th grade Physical Science	Funds used to resupply water quality test kits for water quality studies that compare forested and agricultural stretches of a local stream. (Funded previously four times since 2003.)
