



## Fall 2009 Professional Development Workshops

**All Project Learning Tree workshops** feature activities that help you accomplish curriculum or youth program goals in meaningful and effective ways. Each offers one graduate professional education credit (variety of universities). Each title is a separate credit. No prerequisites. *New & Improved* PreK-8<sup>th</sup> grade and high school PLT materials offered at all workshops except Focus on Literature (PreK-8<sup>th</sup> only) and "Ecosystem Services of Trees" (high school only).

**PLT Walk in the Forest.** Friday is classroom-based in Boise. Saturday we'll explore the forests—with foresters!—near Idaho City. Co-sponsored by the Society of American Foresters. Receive PLT PreK-8 Activity Guide and *Focus on Forests* PLT High School module. \$25 workshop fee.

**Focus on Literature with WILD, WET & PLT.** For Elementary Educators. Incorporate children's literature with activities from Project's WILD, WET & Learning Tree. Receive your choice of the Project Learning Tree, Project WILD or Project WET Activity Guide and children's literature for your classroom library. **Workshop Fee: \$30.**
