In this 1-credit workshop we'll learn about Service-Learning—combining community service with classroom curriculum. We'll explore what service-learning is and what it is not; experience proven activities from Project's WILD, WET & Learning Tree; practice the steps of a service-learning project; consider methods of assessment to make sure the **learning** part of service-learning is accomplished; and prepare you to use information and activities from the class with your students.

CREDIT: Earn one professional education credit (for recertification and/or moving on the pay scale) from BSU, UI or NNU (\$60), payable at the workshop.

STIPEND and ACCESS TO GRANTS: Through a grant from the American Forest Foundation, \$100 stipends are available to the first 20 high school educators who register and complete the class. All workshop participants will be eligible to apply for PLT GreenWorks' service-learning grants of up to \$5000.
