- Idaho's Forested Endowment Lands: Unique and Uniquely Managed** (23min) HA
Discusses the history of Idaho's endowment forest lands and their role in funding education in Idaho.
- It Takes A Tree** (17.5min) HA
Each of us uses the equivalent of a tree 100 feet tall and 18 inches in diameter each year. See what is done to protect the environment when your tree is cut.
- I Want to Log "Selectively"** (40min) HA
Considers forest ecology, tree growth, and genetics as factors in managing a private forest. Computer models. Great introduction to applied ecology.
- Materials and the Environment** (15min) HA
Looks at the global economic and ecological consequences of using wood or substitute products to support rapidly expanding populations.
